TO THE PERSON(S) OBTAINING LICENSE:

Please be advised that you must comply with all Laws and Ordinances of the State of Michigan and the Municipal Government of the City of Muskegon with regard to holding a dance. In the event that any violation of a Law has occurred by you, your designees or persons attending the dance, a civil infraction or criminal charges against you, your designees or persons attending may be issued as a result of the violation. The Muskegon Police Department has the authority to shut down the dance and disperse those attending in the event a violation of the Laws and/or Ordinances occurs. The most common violations that shall cause your license to be revoked and the dance to be shut down are:

- Allowing or serving alcohol on the premises.
- Operating the dance beyond the designated closing times of 2:00 am for an adult dance or 11:00 pm for a teen dance.
- Allowing a person under the age of 17 years to remain at a public dance after 9:00 pm, unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- Violations of the noise ordinance.
- Disorderly conduct by you or persons attending the dance.
- Failure to have a floor manager on duty.

Note that the above are only the most common violations and are not inclusive. A violation of any of the City Ordinances or State Laws may cause your license to be suspended or revoked, the dance to be shut down, your eligibility for another license cancelled for 6 months and a civil infraction or criminal charges to be issued. The City Ordinance numbers for Dance Hall Permits and Requirements are 50-71 to 50-78. This ordinance and/or other City Ordinances may be obtained at the City Clerk's Office or viewed at the City's web site @ shorelinecity.com.
