

Rules for Evergreen, Lakeside, Restlawn Upright Section

- May 1st flowers and plants can be placed at gravesites.
- September 30th, flowers and plants are to be removed.
- November 25th winter wreaths can be placed. Removed by March 1st.
- Planting in urns are encouraged, urns must be placed to the side of marker or monument, flush to the marker or monument.
- Urn not tended to in 2 years will be removed.
- No lot should be defined by bricks, hedges, edging, etc. Any kind of ground coverage is not permitted.
- No hanging baskets or baskets suspended from any type of hook.
- Plantings in ground cannot exceed 12" from the front or back of the marker or monument. Anything that impede maintenance will cut down.
- No artificial flowers placed in ground or glass containers.
- Cemetery is not liable for monuments, markers, urns, flowers, decorations etc.
- Cemetery water is not for human consumption.
- No persons allowed in cemetery after dark.
- Leash laws are in effect.
- No vehicles allowed on grass walk aisles.

Rules for Restlawn Cemetery

- Memorial Day flowers can be placed the Thursday before and must be removed the next weekend.
- Wreaths placed November 25th, removed March 1st.
- No permanent planting of any kind, trees, bushes, flowers, etc.
- No glass containers.
- Cemetery assumes no liability for monuments, vases, flowers, decorations, etc.
- Cemetery water not for human consumption.
- No persons allowed after dark.
- Leash laws are in effect.
- Upright section of Restlawn has separate rules.

Rules for Evergreen Cemetery Mausoleum

-The Mausoleum is kept locked; visitors must sign out the key at office, 1350 E. Keating Ave. Office hours Monday-Friday, 8am to 4:30pm excluding holidays.

-Vases should be purchased for flowers or decorations.

-No decorations allowed on the floor, only what fits inside the vases. Decorations deemed unsightly will be removed by cemetery personnel.

-Mausoleum will be open during the Memorial Day weekend.
