### FILING REQUIREMENTS:

Non-Partisan Nominating Petitions and Affidavit of Identity to be filed with the Muskegon City Clerk by 4:00 p.m. Petition forms must be filled out completely and correctly with a minimum of **50 valid qualified signatures**. The Affidavit must be signed in front of a notary.

### FILING DEADLINE:

Tuesday, April 25, 2023 by 4:00 p.m.

### ELECTION DATES:

A Primary Election will be conducted if the number of candidates that file for a position is greater than two times the number of positions to be elected.

Primary Election ~ Tuesday, August 8, 2023

General Election ~ Tuesday, November 7, 2023

### MICHIGAN CAMPAIGN FINANCE:

All candidates must file a Statement of Organization for Candidate Committee with the Muskegon County Clerk if one has not already been filed. Each candidate is responsible for reporting contributions and expenditures related to their campaign in the appropriate format and in compliance with the laws of the State of Michigan.
