



Project Name: Lower W. Western Rehabilitation, Shoreline Drive to West End

Project Type: Rehabilitation, including some new water main, new road, new sidewalks, and new driveways. While the curbs will move, most of the pavement will be saved and resurfaced.

Project Summary: Lower W. Western Avenue was originally designed to serve large industrial factories. As things change along this street from industrial to residential and mixed-use, this project will make the street safer, more walkable, and better suited to the kinds of housing and businesses that are moving into the area.

Changes to Expect: The lanes will no longer be too wide, parking spaces will be more formally marked, greenspace will increase and sidewalks will be added.

Timeline/Timeframe: The project is expected to start around April 1 and will be complete by the end of summer.

Lane, Road or Intersection Shutdown: Parts of W. Western will be closed with detours signed to get residents and customers to the right place. Access to businesses may be more complicated than usual, including driving on temporary surfaces like gravel.
