Contact the Cemetery Department for over-sized monuments for approval. We must know the height, width, and weight for Family Monuments.

OAKWOOD-EVERGREEN-LAKESIDE CEMETERIES

Flower urns should be placed on either side of the monument or a minimum of 3" behind the monument, or centered on a 4 of more grave lot so it can be properly maintained during the summer months.

MARKERS AND MONUMENTS

The Cemetery Department reserves the right to determine the location of any marker or monument on any grave.

No more than one marker shall be allowed on one grave space.

All memorials and/or monuments must be made of the highest quality standard bronze or granite.

Single Grave:

36x14x4 inches thick for Restlawn Flat Section

36x14 no height restriction for Restlawn Upright, Lakeside, Oakwood and Evergreen Cemeteries

Double Graves:

Not to exceed

48x14x4 inches thick for Restlawn Flat Section

48x14 no height restriction for Restlawn Upright, Lakeside, Oakwood and Evergreen Cemeteries

Prior to placing an order for monument or marker with an online company please refer to cemetery requirements as to the material that they are made of. Not all online are made with required material and thickness. Local monument companies can also be contacted regarding materials used.

All bronze markers may have a granite or other suitable base; approved by office.

A Monument Monugrid charge is placed on all markers installed in cemetery and covers setting, straightening and trimming of markers.

Any marker smaller than 16x8x4 would be considered temporary and/or decorative in which the cemetery rules apply to them. ****Effective November 1, 2021****

****Temporary and/or decorative markers shall adhere to same cemetery rules and only be placed beginning May 1st and removed September 30th.****

****The cemetery is not responsible to any damage incurred and it is the owner's responsibility to remove temporary/decorative marker.****
