Beach includes replacement of the relay panel, retrofit safety grate on wet well, install valve chamber sump pump, reseal and coat control panel, install lifting chains and pressure gauges, and all other associated work. Barney includes reseal and coat control panel, install lifting chains and pressure gauges, and all other associated work.
