

## Welcome to Glenside Neighborhood!

The board of the Glenside Neighborhood Association welcomes you to the neighborhood. We are a friendly neighborhood of families, singles, couples and pets of all ages. We take pride in our homes, yards and love McGraft Park, the jewel of the neighborhood. Here are some tips and things to expect in Glenside:

- Garbage pickup west of Wickham is Monday morning; garbage day east of Wickham is
   Tuesday morning. Use the dark green totter supplied by the city. Spring through late fall, the
   city also picks up yard waste on the same day as your regular garbage day. Yard waste should
   be placed curbside in either yard waste paper bags (available at local retailers) or rigid,

- Recycling is free for city residents who enroll in the program. To enroll, call DPW Offices at 231-724-4100 or enroll online at https://www.muskegon-mi.gov/departments/public-works/city-of-muskegon-recycling-program/.
- The Glenside Neighborhood Association meets the third Wednesday of every month at the McGraft Park building at 7pm. Please join us!

- We are in the fourth ward of the city and represented by Teresa Emory on the city commission.
- The neighborhood association sponsors several neighborhood events. They include an annual Easter Egg Hunt, Halloween Party, Ice Cream Social, Neighborhood Yard Sale, Pooch Parade, and Holiday Santa Visit. We also have 2 Dumpster Days (spring & fall).
- Glenside delivers a quarterly newsletter and has a Facebook page.
- The city sponsors summer concerts in McGraft Park, usually on Tuesday evenings, which are open and free to the public.
