Solicitor (peddler) A person who goes from place to place, or house to house, or who stands in any street or public place taking or offering to take orders for merchandise or services to be performed in the future. In the event the solicitation is for advance payment of services or merchandise to be delivered later, the solicitor shall deposit with the City Clerk a bond, certified check or cash in the amount of \$1000.00 in favor of the city, such bond, check or cash (hereinafter "security") to be available for any claim made by any person who has not received the services or merchandise within the time and in the manner promised by the solicitor. The bond shall remain in full force and effect or retained by the City for a period of ninety (90) days after the expiration of the business registration issued to the solicitor.

Charitable and Religious Solicitors Shall be required to have a business registration certificate. No fee is required if the applicant shows the following to the City Clerk:

- That the charity being represented is fully registered with the State of Michigan
- That any merchandise is described in full and examples are supplied with the application
- No security is required provided the requirements of this section are met

The fee for a solicitor is \$150.00 and shall expire on or before May 1 of each year.

All debts owed the City excluding real property or income taxes must be paid in full.
